AN EVOLVING CATHOLIC UNIVERSITY

Founded by the Felician Sisters of North America, Felician University began as Immaculate Conception Normal School in 1923.

In 1997, the college purchased the Fairleigh Dickinson University Rutherford Campus, a 12-acre complex that provides housing for 480 students in two large residence halls, and has an athletics facility, four academic buildings, including a student center, a radio station, a computer lab, a little theater, and Iviswold Castle, listed on the New Jersey Register of Historic Places.

A major restoration of the Castle was completed in 2013; it currently houses the President's Office, a university Chapel, and several administrative offices. Most recently, a new Wellness and Recreation Center was built to provide a new fitness center and other facilities.

Today, Felician is one of 20 Franciscan universities in the United States and remains the only Catholic, Franciscan, private, independent institution in New Jersey.

With the addition of the Rutherford campus, the University continues to operate on the 40-acre campus in Lodi, which includes Obal Hall and the 1,500 seat Breslin Performing Arts Center, the University Child Care Center, Kirby Hall, STEM Center and newly renovated state-of-the-art STEM labs, and the Felician Sisters' Immaculate Conception Convent.








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FELICIAN UNIVERSITY TODAY

Felician University has enjoyed strong increases in enrollment and improvements in student success, with a continuing focus on inclusive excellence, shared governance, new partnerships and programs, growing net revenue, and continued facilities enhancements, including a new athletics complex. It has recently received over \$20 million in federal and state grants to maintain and grow programs focused on student success.

Felician enrolls approximately 2,100 students, almost half of whom are first-generation college students, representing diverse religious, racial, and ethnic backgrounds. 79% of students are undergraduates, 18% are graduates, and 2% are non-matriculated. Nearly 74% of students are women and the vast majority, 90%, originate from New Jersey. The campus is primarily a commuter campus with only 30% of undergraduates living on campus.

As a Hispanic Serving and Minority Serving Institution, Felician University is majority minority, offering a diverse and inclusive campus and classroom culture that truly embodies the Franciscan charism of brotherhood, sisterhood, and care of the world. 40% of undergraduates are Hispanic and 20% are Black or Asian Americans.




Felician University is dedicated to making highquality education accessible to all, ensuring excellence in learning is both attainable and affordable for our students. One hundred percent of incoming freshmen receive a scholarship or grant award. One-to-one advising for both university and outside scholarship opportunities offers students the support and direction they need to navigate their university education at the lowest possible

The student-to-faculty ratio is 14:1, with 230 dedicated faculty (84 full-time; 146 part-time). This allows for greater discussion-based teaching, oneon-engagement, flexibility in classroom needs, and tailored opportunities for experiential learning.

The University offers more than 60 majors, minors, and concentrations in four academic schools, including new online and hybrid programs: the School of Arts & Sciences, School of Business and Information Sciences, School of Education, and School of Nursing.

The Center for Academic Success and Effectiveness (CASE) provides resources for Felician students as they work to maximize their full academic potential. The new STEM Center fosters student collaboration and active hands-on learning



to prepare students for leadership and teamwork nursing programs in the nation and is #2 in New as they enter the workforce.

Felician University is uniquely located 10 miles and 20 minutes from New York City. New York is the number one visitor's destination in the United States, home to 8.5 million people, a world capital for finance, industry, and the arts, and one of the most culturally and linguistically diverse metropolitan areas around the globe.

Felician University has consistently been ranked by Niche.com as one of the safest as well as one of the best located campuses in New Jersey.

The University is accredited by the Middle States Commission on Higher Education. Felician ranked third among private institutions in New Jersey for best value in 2020-2021, according to payscale. com.

Jersey. US News & World Report ranked Felician #23 in the Northeast in Social Mobility.


